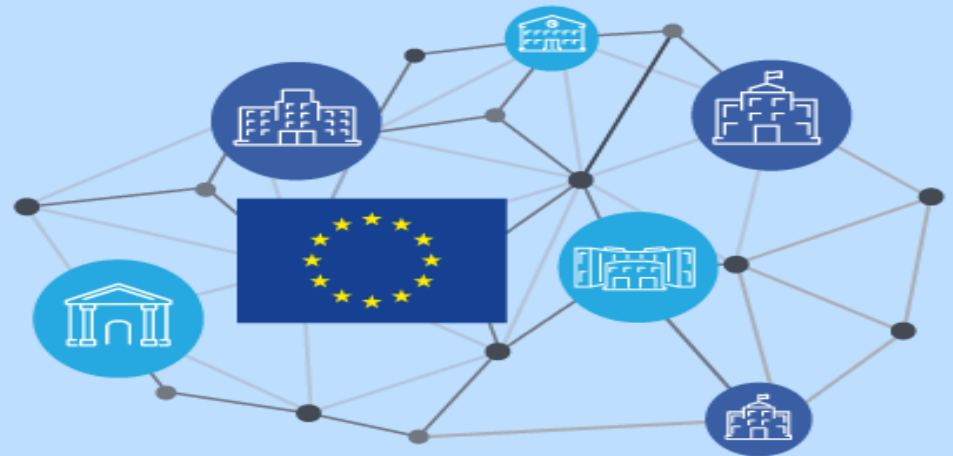

2 May 2018: EC presented its long-term budget proposal for the 2021-2027 period

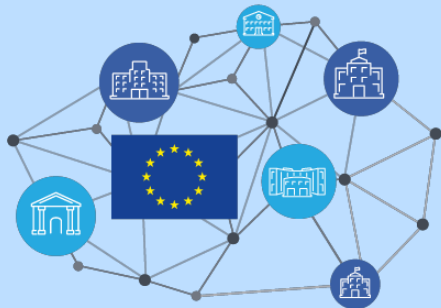
May 30: outlines on how the budget will be invested. The Commission proposed to **double the Erasmus budget to €30 billion.**

“.....Member States, Council and the Commission encourage the emergence by 2024 of some twenty 'European Universities', consisting in **bottom-up networks of 4 to 6 universities across the EU** which will enable students to obtain a **degree by combining studies in several EU countries** and contribute to the international **competitiveness** of European universities.”

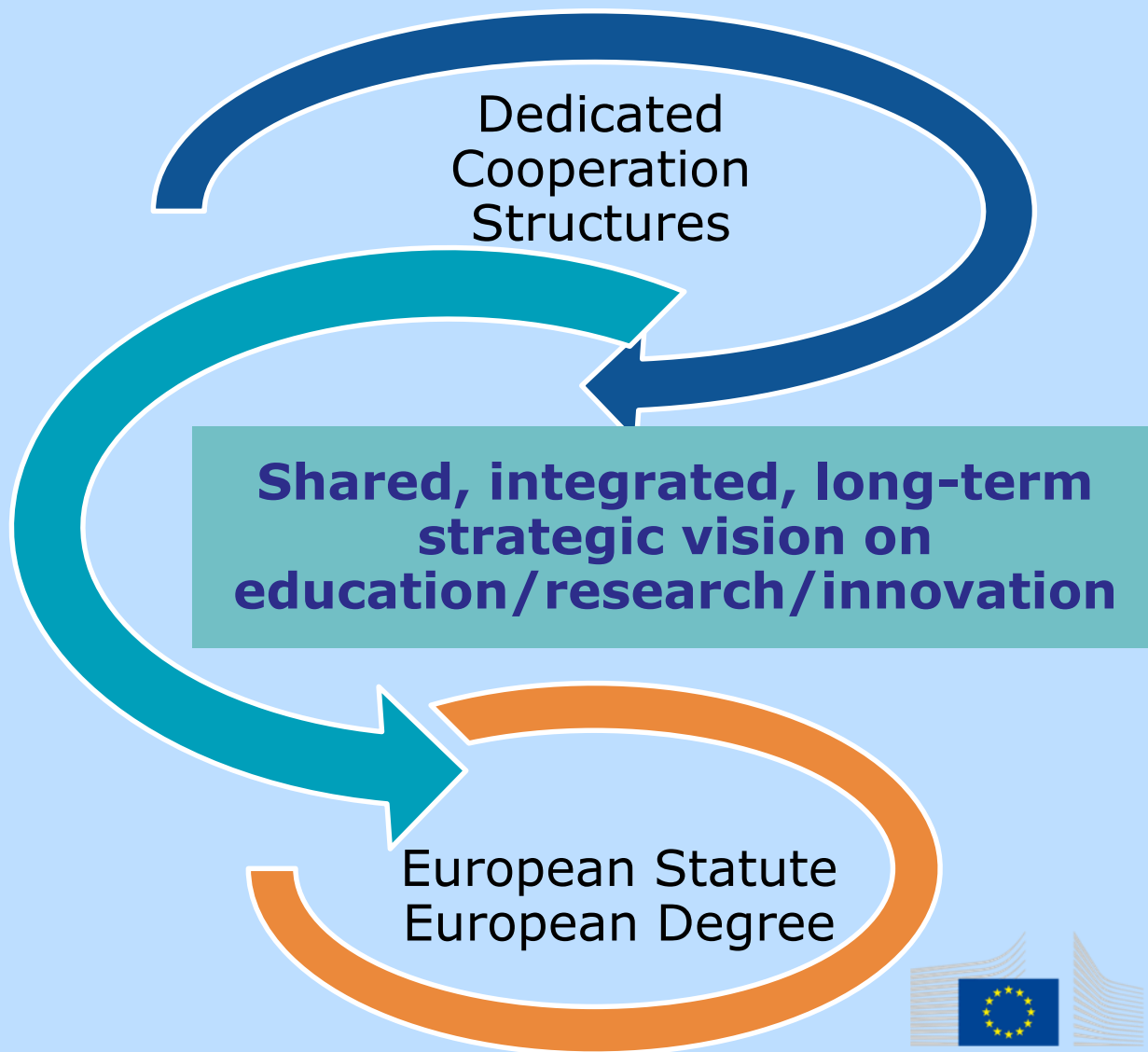
...increase **quality**, **performance** and **competitiveness** of European higher education institutions

How 'European Universities' will look like in 2025-2030?

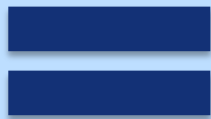
European curriculum customised by each student leading to a **European degree**

Enhanced staff mobility between the partner institutions to teach/do research/work



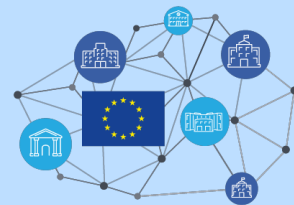

The Erasmus+ calls will support higher education institutions in:



Going beyond existing higher education cooperation models

Building a growing level of integration

Dedicated Cooperation Structures + pooling of resources, services, data, infrastructure

Testing phase 2019 and 2020

2 calls for European Universities launched under 2019 and 2020 Erasmus+ Work Programmes as centralised actions

Funding duration of 3 years

Possibility to reapply under the next MFF after a positive evaluation
