






Independent qualitative Evaluation of Projects funded by the ERC 2019

The overall results of the 2019 exercise for all of the evaluated projects and split by call type (AdG and StG) are shown in Figure 1.







Can frontier research also make societal impact?

Impact is not evaluated or required for the ERC, but they are happy if 'spillover' happens.

Don't be afraid to present impact as part of what is considered scientific excellence in your discipline.




<u>15 grantees</u> who transformed science were highlighted when the ERC reached its 10,000th grant milestone.

All were chosen for Science excellence but their societal and economic impact is evident as well.

Transferability to Pillar 2

Create global visibility for a research agenda.

Build capacity and a track record for an organisation, department or research team.


Step towards Pillar 2 via MSCA.

Some evaluation reports for unsuccessful applications point the way towards applying to calls where impact can give you an edge.

An ERC project is large and ambitious, parts of the research agenda or team can be spun-off.

<u>Proof of Concept calls give additional funding</u> to commercialise or make societal impact
