


# **COST Actions**

AN EFFICIENT NETWORKING TOOL

#### COST provides funding

for research coordination and capacity building activities

COST is not funding research itself, but pooling resources and research results by networking



Memorandum of Understanding

#### 4 years


Min 7 countries, average participation 30 countries



# UK participation in COST: key figures 2019
























# **Travel Reimbursement rules**



# Daily allowance (DA) covers:

- Hotel
- Meals
- Local travel in meeting country

## Based on:

- Meeting country
- Travel times

## Long distance travel (≥101 km) covers total travel expenses up to 1500 EUR

- Meeting country €160-200
- Travel times
- Meals offered by Local Organiser (-10% deducted per provided meal)

## Others:

- Visa costs
- Travel cancellation insurance



# What is the maximum grant amount for each type?

## • STSM

## ✓ Up to **4000 EUR**

- -request to prepay 50% is possible but decision lies with GH Institution
- Virtual Mobility Grant
  Up to 1500 EUR

- ITC Conference Grants and Dissemination Conference Grants
  - ✓ Up to 2000 EUR per grant for face to face conferences

OR


✓ Up to 500 EUR for virtual conferences



# Virtual Networking Support



- Promoting and supporting virtual and hybrid collaboration as a complement to traditional ways of collaboration within the research and innovation communities
- Individual Grant (EUR 4000 per grant). Follow on e-COST the Grant Awarding Process.
  - Selected by Open Call or identification of relevant participant.
